



Admission to M.Sc. Program in Digital Humanities, AY 2026-27

IIT Jodhpur invites applications for admission to M.Sc. program in Digital Humanities offered by the *Interdisciplinary Research Platform (IDRP) of Digital Humanities* for the Semester commencing from July 2026.

The M.Sc. Digital Humanities program brings together pedagogy and research from a wide range of academic disciplines to learn, innovate, and apply computational techniques to the arts, humanities, social and basic sciences. Students in the program shall be trained to appreciate the application and impact of computational methods in various areas such as cultural heritage, libraries, archives, and other sociocultural facets while developing skills that relevant employers seek in their prospective employees.

A. Application Procedure

Applicants are requested to use the following link to fill and submit the application form online:

For admission to the 2026-2027 First Semester commencing in July 2026, this online link will remain active till 30 March 2026

Applicants are required to pay a processing fee of Rs. 300 for GEN-UR, GEN-EWS, and OBC applicants, and Rs. 150 for SC, ST, and PD applicants, online when submitting the application form. This fee is non-refundable. It may be noted that there is no provision to edit the Application Form in the ERP Portal of the Institute after the final submission of the Application Form. Application Form with incomplete/ incorrect details will be outrightly rejected.

Applicants shortlisted for the admission process will be required to bring the final submitted application form duly signed along with a copy of all educational testimonials at the time of admission.

B. Eligibility for Admission

The eligibility criteria are prescribed below and represent the absolute minimum requirements. The relaxation for SC/ST/PD candidates in the qualifying degree marks is as per the rules of the Ministry of Education, Government of India, as amended from time to time.

Qualifying Degree	Marks obtained in Qualifying Degree
A minimum of Bachelor's Degree or an equivalent qualification awarded by any university established by an Act of the central or state legislature in India, or by other educational institutions established by an Act of Parliament, or recognized as a deemed university under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956. Additionally, the Bachelor's Degree or equivalent must entail a minimum of three years of education following the completion of higher secondary schooling (10+2) or its equivalent. The Bachelor's Degree should be either in the academic disciplines of Humanities or Social Sciences or Basic Sciences.	At least 60% marks or a minimum Cumulative Performance Index (CPI)/Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 6.0 on a 10-point scale for GEN/EWS/OBC candidates, and at least 55% marks or a minimum CPI/CGPA of 5.5 on a 10-point scale for SC/ST/PD candidates.

C. Reservation Policy

The norms of reservation shall be adopted as laid down by the Ministry of Education, Government of India, as amended from time to time.

D. Admission under Sports Quota

Two supernumerary seats under the regular admission category shall be given to sportspersons in each M.Sc. program. **See Annexure -I for details and the link for sports quota applications.**

F. Important Note on Eligibility and Admission Cancellation

"IIT Jodhpur reserves the right to immediately cancel the admission of any candidate at any stage of the admission process or at any stage of the program, if it is found that the candidate does not fulfill the prescribed eligibility criteria as per the official advertisement or the candidate has provided incorrect/incomplete information in the Application Form. The decision of the Institute in such matters will be final and will be binding on the candidates. All legal matters shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the Competent Court and Forum in Jodhpur, Rajasthan, India only."

A. Guidelines for Admission to the Seats Reserved under Sports Quota for M.Sc. Programs are as follows:

1. Two supernumerary seats under the regular admission category shall be given to sportspersons in each M.Sc. program.
2. The Sports Quota will be available to only those sportspersons who can produce certification about securing top three positions (in team or individual events) in national or international tournaments approved by SAI or other recognized sports federations, or who were part of a national team at junior or senior level in tournaments approved by these institutions. This will include both outdoor and indoor sports.
3. Age relaxation will be as per the Government of India norms for such candidates.
4. It is mandatory to meet the minimum eligibility criteria as per the program requirements.
5. The weightage for the interview and/or written examination, and sports certificate(s), shall be 50% and 50%, respectively.
6. The weightage for the Sports Certificate may be calculated as follows:
 - A person getting any of the first three positions in the Olympic/World Game/Commonwealth Game/World Cup Tournaments /Asian Games - **50 marks (out of 50)**
 - A person representing India in the above-mentioned games/tournaments - **40 marks (out of 50)**
 - A person representing India in any other official matches abroad and within the country approved by SAI or other recognized sports federations - **35 marks (out of 50)**

 - The above marks shall be calculated on the basis of the highest performance in sports during the last five years from the last date of application.
 - The marks for the above awards will not be clubbed.

Resolving Ties

In the case of a tie at any stage in the preparation of the merit list, candidates with equal marks will be grouped together. Their merit will be determined according to the following order of criteria:

- Year of achievement (Preference shall be given to achievements in the year closer to the year of application).
- Academic performance at the undergraduate level (Preference shall be given to higher academic performance).
- If two or more candidates secure equal marks in all the above, the candidate senior in age shall rank higher in the order of merit.
