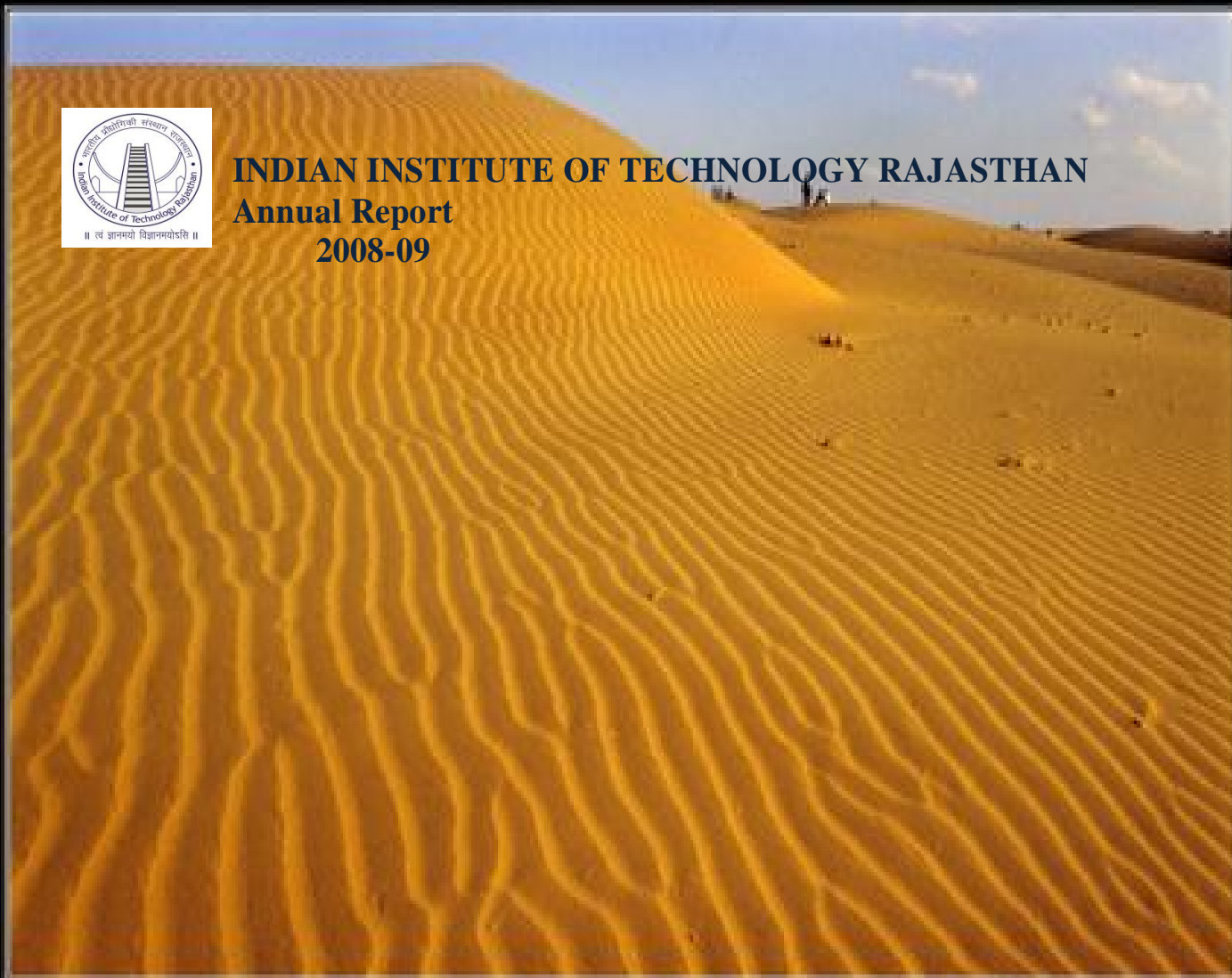

Establishment of IIT Rajasthan

The Govt. of India, in its 11th Five Year Plan announced eight new IITs for starting admissions from the academic session of August, 2008, valuing the role of IITs in the prosperity of India. IIT Rajasthan is one amongst the new IITs established in 2008 with a four year B.Tech. programme in three branches of Computer Science & Engineering, Electrical Engineering and Mechanical Engineering having student strength of 40 in each branch and started at its mentor Institute i.e. IIT Kanpur.

Functioning of the Institute

MHRD vide its order F. No. 11-10/2008-TS.I (Pt) dated July 21, 2008 designated the Director of the mentor Institute, IIT Kanpur, as the Director of IIT Rajasthan, and the Chairperson of the Board of Governors of the mentoring IIT as the Chairperson of the Institute till a regular Chairperson of the Board of Governors of IIT Rajasthan is appointed.

MHRD vide its order no. F. No. 22-19/2008-TS.I dated August 1, 2008 has also accorded sanction for creation of following posts in respect of IIT Rajasthan.

Later, the MHRD vide its order no. F.No. 11-10/2008-TS.I dated September 2, 2008 conveyed its decision that selection committees for recruitment of faculty of existing IITs shall also be selection committees for the IITs mentored by them.

It was decided that teacher: student ratio in the Institute would be 1:10 for creation of non faculty posts at the Institute. It was also decided that the Faculty : Non-faculty in the Institute shall be 1:1.1 vide MHRD letter no. F.No 44-5/2008/TS.I dated October 29, 2008.

Further the MHRD vide its order no F.No. 44-5/2008/TS.I dated February 26, 2009 has accorded sanction for creation of 24 non-faculty posts at the Institute as under:

India which was presided by Shri Kalicharan Saraf, Hon'ble Education Minister, Govt. of Rajasthan.

Course Structure

UG Programme

The curriculum, course structure and syllabus for the first year courses and fee structure and other rules has been followed broadly same as in the mentor IIT i.e. IIT Kanpur. The first year classes held at IIT Kanpur and the students admitted will be relocated to the place in Rajasthan where new IIT will be established.

The institute offers B.Tech. UG programmes in the following disciplines:

1. Computer Science & Engineering
2. Electrical Engineering
3. Mechanical Engineering

Information brochure containing orientation programme and students registration data was distributed to the IIT Rajasthan students and parents. To give an introduction about the mentor institute, Help Desk, Documents, Fee required for registration and other facilities.

The sanctioned strength of the students for the first academic year (2008-2009) has been decided as 120 for 3 UG programme (B.Tech.) having CSE, EE and Mechanical Engineering disciplines with students strength of 40 each. The details of which are as under:

*** There will be 3% horizontal reservation for Physically Challenged category students across all categories, besides all the reservation & admission norms of Government of India presently in vogue at all other IITs.**

Based on the counseling of the qualified candidates in JEE 2008, 112 students were offered seats in IIT Rajasthan including 8 girls. After inauguration on August 2, 2008, the classes for the students commenced from 4th August 2008 for the 1st Semester.

Facilities

Present Campus

At present IIT Rajasthan is functioning at the Campus of IIT Kanpur. All major Lecture halls, Labs, Computer Centers and Central Library and other facilities established by IIT Kanpur for their students were made available for students of IIT Rajasthan.

Offices

For the purpose of establishing temporary offices, IIT Kanpur has earmarked certain facilities like big office space for the use of IIT Rajasthan on the top floor of the newly constructed Helicopter research building, for setting up the Director's office, Administrative, Academic, Students and Faculty offices along with Study Space, Computer Centre, and Library etc.



Lecturer Halls

The state of art Lecture Halls of IIT Kanpur will be shared on alternate shift basis. The classes for the IIT Rajasthan will be held in the afternoon session during which the availability of IITK class-rooms is ensured.



Laboratories

The highly advanced and technically equipped state of art laboratories of IIT Kanpur will be shared on shift basis. The Labs experimentation for the IIT Rajasthan will be held in the morning session during which the availability is ensured.



Student Hostel

For the stay of IIT Rajasthan Students on the Campus of IIT Kanpur existing 7 two storeyed Type V apartments are being furnished in the dormitory model for accommodating about fifteen students in each apartment in the middle of the faculty houses, providing ample ambience for comfortable stay of IIT Rajasthan Students on the green campus of IIT Kanpur. Dining facility is also provided in one of the student housing apartments.



Library

Top floor of Helicopter research building of IIT Kanpur allocated for IIT Rajasthan, a space has been earmarked for Library purpose. For the purpose of borrowing reference books and referring the journals, a highly equipped multi-storeyed P K Kelkar Library with digital archiving and on line reference was also made available on specific terms of usage for IIT Rajasthan students.



Computer Centre

Initially the computer Centre of IIT Kanpur has been shared on available slots. Top floor of Helicopter research building of IIT Kanpur allocated for IIT Rajasthan, a space has been earmarked for development of

Computer Center Lab. All the hostels are equipped with Internet facility.



Health Services

The students of IIT Rajasthan were allowed to avail the medical OPD services at the Primary Health Centre of IIT Kanpur under Institutional tie up.

Critical and emergency health care was arranged to be availed from identified super and multi specialty hospitals including tie-up with Regency Hospital in the city of Kanpur on cashless hospitalization tie up taking individual medical insurance from public sector medical insurance provider. For this purpose medical insurance was made compulsory for all the students of IIT Rajasthan.



Besides above security and housekeeping facilities were also provided to IIT Rajasthan students by the mentor Institute.

Sports

The students of IIT Rajasthan were participated in different intra Institute sports events for girls and boys separately like Badminton, Basketball, Athletic, Tug of War & Twenty Nine for Girls and Volleyball, Weight Lifting, Athletic, Badminton, Football, Table Tennis, Chess, Bridge and Skating for boys. The girls won basketball and 4 out of 6 badminton matches against the Y8 batch of IITK and won the boys volleyball team over the Y8. In athlete the students came 3rd in the cross country held during the Kali Puja tournament. Among all fresher students won a bronze medal in Weightlifting-Udghosh.

Total 10 students, 8 boys and two girls of IIT Rajasthan participated in inter IIT sports meet held at IIT Madras.

Website and Temporary Logo for IIT Rajasthan

Mentoring Institute organized the logo competition for IIT Rajasthan. The temporary logo for IIT Rajasthan with the theme of Jantar Mantar 'the astronomical observatory of Jaipur to commemorate the scientific knowledge of medieval India has been adopted for the use of the institute till the final adoption of the Logo.

Independent Day Celebration

The first Independent Day celebration was held on August 15, 2008 along with IIT Kanpur students at 8.00 AM. The Director, faculty, staff and students were present. A **Fine Arts Club** was started on 19th September, 2008 with the sole objective of this Club was to let people roam free with their imagination and help those talents to come out of their shells and to incline all students towards arts of any kind.

On 21st September, 2008 a **Dramatics club** was started for participation in Antaragni'08.

On 14th October, 2008 a Dance Team comprising of 6 boys and 4 girls was made on the basis of the dance club for participation in Antaragni'08. On 19th October 2008 a fine arts competition was held. Out of 52 participants the artworks of Swathi, Arjun, Nirmal, Prateek were appreciated.

In Antaragni'08 in October 23-26 the students participated in dance, dramatics-parody making, rangoli making, clay modeling, tattoo making, quizzes and treasure hunt and stood 4th in Parody making, 5th in treasure hunt and 2nd in clay modeling.

Registration of the Society of IIT Rajasthan

The IIT Rajasthan was registered as Society under Rajasthan Societies Registration Act 1958 by the Registrar, Institutions vide registration no. 1158/Jaipur 2008-2009 on March 24, 2009, in absence of passing of amendment of IIT Act 1961 Bill from the parliament.

The Memorandum of Association was signed for the Society by the Chairman, Members and the Director with the objectives of and power of the Board in the MoA.
