Advertisement for Institute Post-Doctoral Fellowships at IIT Jodhpur

Applications are invited from Indian Nationals or Foreign Nationals including “Persons of Indian Origin” (PIO) or Overseas Citizens of India (OCI), with consistently good academic record and interdisciplinary research potential, for full-time Post-Doctoral Fellowships (PDFs) to carryout research & teaching in the following category:

1. Institute Post-Doctoral Fellowships – for General and Reserved Categories

These are temporary research positions which may be offered to those who seek to choose research as a profession. Post-Doctoral Fellows are expected to further enhance the interdisciplinary research culture at the Institute. The current call is for Post-Doctoral research in the following Centers: (i) Center for Emerging Technologies for Sustainable Development (CETSD), (ii) Center For Technology Foresight and Policy (CTFP) (iii) Center for Education and Technology for Education (CETE). Additional projects for these research positions will be announced on this website.

1.1.1 Applicant's Eligibility

Applicant must hold Ph.D. with first class or equivalent grade in preceding degree in respective discipline, with a consistently good academic record & demonstrative evidence of research output (Papers and/or Patents). The candidates are eligible to apply within five years after completion of Ph.D.

Ph.D. scholars after submission of thesis are also eligible to apply for Institute PDF posts. However, they have to submit the provisional/degree certificate within 6 months from the date of appointment as Institute PDF. If not submitted within the time limit, the appointment will stand cancelled or a decision will be taken in consultation with thesis processing authority.

IIT Jodhpur Ph.D. scholars will be not be eligible to apply for Institute PDF.

Post Doc's joining IIT Jodhpur will not be eligible to apply for Faculty positions of IIT Jodhpur.

1.1.2 Age Limit

Applicants for the Post-Doctoral Fellowship must not exceed 32 years for male and 35 years for female candidates (to be relaxed by 5 years in case of persons with physical disability, SC and ST and 3 years in case of OBC-NCL)

1.1.3 Duration

The duration of the fellowship is initially for a period of 2 years, extendable for a further period of one more year. Progress of the Post-Doctoral Fellow will be assessed every year by a committee constitute for this purpose.

1.1.4 Fellowship Grant

Post-Doctoral Fellow shall be paid a fellowship amount between 55,000-65,000/- consolidated per month (depending upon experience and qualification). If available, suitable on-campus accommodation may be provided as per IIT Jodhpur norms or HRA (as per rules).



1.1.5 Other Benefits

(a) Contingency Grant: A contingency grant of Rs. 50,000 per annum will be provided to the Post-Doctoral Fellow for research purpose. The unspent amount can be carried over to the next financial year.

(b) Medical benefits: At par with the Ph.D. Students.

1.1.6 Responsibilities

Research, Teaching/Teaching Assistance as decided by the Institute.

1.1.7 Leave

The Post-Doctoral Fellow is eligible for leave for upto 30 days in a year (two and a half day per month) for each completed year of the fellowship. The leave can be availed on a prorata basis for the duration.

1.1.8 Termination

If the Post-Doctoral Fellow wishes to leave the program before the end of the tenure, he/she can do so with prior consent of the PAC and by giving one month's notice. The Fellowship may be terminated by the Institute, if the performance/conduct of the Fellow is unsatisfactory, by giving one month's notice to the Fellow.

General Instruction to Applicants:

Interested candidates may apply with all the details requested in ONLINE application placed on the online portal of IIT Jodhpur (www.iitj.ac.in). Further.

1. For the list of projects candidates are required to go through the web page of the Advertisement which contains the list of the projects with name of the PIs and Affiliation. Applications are invited in those areas only in addition to the requirement of centers.
2. One candidate can apply in maximum of two projects.
3. The advertisement is open for General and Reserved Category applicants.
4. This is a rolling advertisement and applications are welcomed throughout the year. The applicants are required to apply only through ONLINE process only and upload relevant documents accordingly. Please do not send any hard copy of the document.
5. Selection process will involve shortlisting at relevant academic unit and shortlisted candidates will be called for presentation on the proposed work and interview.
6. The performance of the Post-Doctoral Fellow(s) will be assessed by the Performance Assessment Committee (PAC) as per Institute's norms. The performance of a fellow will be evaluated after the one year by a committee and based on satisfactory performance only the fellowship will be extended further for second year.
7. The positions are purely on contract/temporary basis.
8. The candidate will be engaged as per the norms of the Institute.
9. The fellows are not eligible to receive any other fellowship from any Government or Non-Governmental source during the tenure of the fellowship.
10. Application with insufficient information or without relevant supporting documents will not be considered for further processing.
11. The Institute may verify the antecedents or documents submitted by a person at the time of appointment or during the tenure of the service. In case, it is detected that the documents submitted by the candidates are fake or the candidate has a clandestine antecedents or background and has suppressed the said information, then his or her services shall be terminated.



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12. The prescribed essential qualification and experience indicated are bare minimum, and mere possessions of same will not entitle the applicants to be called for interview. Where number of applications received in response to an advertisement is large, it may not be convenient and/or possible for the Institute to conduct interview for all the applicants. In such cases, the Institute may restrict the number of applicants to be called for interview to a reasonable limit, on the basis of qualification and experience higher than that of the minimum prescribed in the advertisement. Therefore, applicants should furnish details of all the qualifications and experience possessed in the relevant field, over and above (if any) the minimum qualification prescribed along with documentary evidences.
13. In case of exceptional candidates, the Institute reserves the right to relax age, qualifications and/or experience. Applicants are requested to upload the certificates in required format along with the application form.
14. The Institute reserves the right to fill or not to fill any or all of the advertised posts.

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
