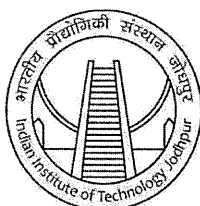

29.2.3	<b>Discussion on establishment and operation of Academic Bank of Credit</b>
	The Ministry of Education in its letter number F.No. 32-7/2020-TS-1 dated 17 November 2021, requested all IITs to take appropriate steps for registering on the ABC Platform at the earliest. In pursuance to the recommendation at Para 11.9 of National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) platform has been developed by National E-Governance Division (NeGD) of MeitY. It has also been suggested to provide student counselling and guidance to all students desirous of opening an Academic Bank Account with Academic Bank of Credits.



	<p>Academic Bank of Credit (ABC) has been established vide UGC's (Establishment and Operation of Academic Bank of Credit (ABC) in Higher Education) Regulations, 2021 under Deptt. of Higher Education, Ministry of Education. Institutions of National Importance as decided by the Government of India are eligible to register with Academic Bank of Credits, vide gazette notification No. CG-DL-E-28122021-232215 dated 28 December 2021. The restriction on the HEIs to participate in the ABC has been removed. Now, all HEIs/Universities in India established or incorporated by or under a Central Act, a Provincial Act or a State Act; the institutions Deemed-to be Universities declared as such under Section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 (3 of 1956); and the Autonomous Colleges and the institutions of National Importance as declared by the Government of India and specially empowered by an Act of parliament to confer or grant degrees are eligible to register with Academic Bank of Credit.</p> <p>The proposal was discussed in the Academic Committee in its meeting held on 13 April 2022. ACM has suggested that students registered with IITJ can register and earn credits of 800 level courses from other IITs, after successfully completing at least 50% credits at the Institute. Students from other IITs may further be allowed to register for 800 level courses offered at IITJ. The credits earned for 800 level courses may be transferred to IITJ from other IITs and vis-a-vis</p> <p>The Senate deliberated on the matter and advised that as there are lots of implications in terms of Academic Regulations of various Programs. The matter should be first discussed at the Department level and later the inputs can be placed before the Senate.</p>

It is a massive initiative to digitally transform the delivery, access, affordability and quality of healthcare services in India in the coming years. Its goal is to enable the country's health system to move towards the Sustainable Development Goal of Universal Health Coverage (UHC). In addition, it is expected to drive positive changes in healthcare record management, and improve coordination among different sectors of healthcare, and build digital bridges between rural and urban India, as well as between different stakeholders of the healthcare ecosystem.</p> <p>In the face of this imminent digital revolution in India's healthcare sector, it is crucial for the stakeholders of the healthcare ecosystem to upskill and reskill themselves in digital healthcare. Learning about the new digital technologies, such as AI, Machine Learning, would be essential in the future for technology-blended healthcare management practices. In addition to capacity building, training would be also required to build social trust on new digital medical implements, such as 'digital doctor', digital diagnosis, 'smart' health devices, medical record-keeping.</p> <p>As India stands at the cusp of a digital healthcare revolution, AIIMS</p>
