#### Office of International Relations

The Director apprised the Board of Governors that IIT Jodhpur with INAE has inaugurated its joint activity center, "IIT Jodhpur Outreach Center" at Gurgaon, NCR on 14<sup>th</sup> November 2023 after approval of the Finance Committee and Board of Governors.

The Board of Governors was also briefed that the Office of IRO has executed more than 20 MoUs and agreements with Foreign Institute/University and major were:

- 1. Agreement for a Joint Ph.D. Degree Programme between IIT Jodhpur and **University at Buffalo** in Metallurgical and Materials Engineering;
- 2. MoU between Drexel University College of Engineering and IIT Jodhpur;
- 3. Cooperation Agreement for establishing a Joint IIT Jodhpur UB Center of Excellence in AI and Data Science; and
- 4. Agreement between **Deutscher Akademischer Austauschdienst (DAAD)** and IIT Jodhpur.

## **Office of Corporate Relations**

The Director apprised the Board of Governors that the Office of Corporate Relations is dedicated to augment the Institutes corporate relations, linkages and outreach. The office is entirely dedicated to building up strong connect with Industry, Ministries and organizations for developing collaborative R&D programmes, finding Industry linked fellowships and scholarships, internships, placements etc.

The Institute signed **67** MoUs and Agreements to foster the Industry connect. Some of the key collaborating partners include INAE, L&T, IFFCO, Pifore Private Limited, Microsoft India R&D Pvt Ltd, Bharat Forge limited, DigitID Technologies private Limited, Vehant Technologies Pvt. Ltd., Tata Consultancy Sevices limited, Rajasthan State Warehousing Corporation, JSW Cement Limited, Secure Meters Limited etc.

## Office of Alumni Relations

The Director further apprised the Board of Governors that the Office of Alumni Relations, IIT Jodhpur expanding its activities to connect with Alumni and briefed the BoG about following key initiatives:

- The First IITJ Connect session was organized in Bangalore on 26<sup>th</sup> Nov 2022. The Bangalore Chapter of the IITJ Alumni society was formally announced during this event. The Second IITJ Connect was organized in IIT ACB Building, Bangalore on 9<sup>th</sup> Sept 2023. Institute has secured 10 incubation spaces for potential incubates and outreach space at the IIT Alumni Centre Bengaluru (IITACB) building;
- Organized **Dashak** on 18<sup>th</sup> 19<sup>th</sup> March 2023: Recognizing the completion of 10 years since the graduation of the first batch of students from IIT Jodhpur, the 10-year reunion for the classes of 2012 and 2013; and

The Director also briefed the Alumni Success Stories / Achievement to the BoG as under:

- ▶ Dr. Anurup Ganguli (B.Tech. ME, Class of 2013) who was working on a stealth launched VedaBio with an initial funding of over \$40 million backed by lead investor OMX Ventures along with a select group of family offices, including Kleinmuntz Associates; and
- The KuKu FM, the audio platform that revolutionized radio, established by Mr. Lal Chand Bisu, Mr. Vikas Goyal, and Mr. Vinod Kumar Meena, who are Alumni of IIT Jodhpur recently secured a substantial investment amounting to \$25 Million in series C funding round co-led by the Nandan Nilekani-founded Fundamentum Partnership and International Finance Corporation.

The Board of Governors appreciated the brief but impressive report by the Director.
