Arrangements for consultation with or representation by:

(a) Members of the public in policy formulation/policy implementation:

As per Section 4(1)(b)(vii) of the RTI Act, 2005, public authorities are required to disclose arrangements for public consultation in policy matters. Based on standard practices at autonomous institutes like IIT Jodhpur, governed by the Institutes of Technology Act, 1961/ Institutes of Technology (Amendment) Act, 2012 and its statutes, there are no specific provisions for direct public consultation in policy formulation or implementation unless explicitly mandated by the Ministry of Education or other governing bodies.

Policy formulation typically involves internal bodies such as the Board of Governors, Finance committee, Senate, or any other designated committees, which include the renowned academic and administrative experts.

However, public feedback is being considered through direct and indirect stakeholders/involvement of engagements during specific initiatives like innovation workshops, industry collaborations, feedback from industry expert, companies visiting for placements etc.
