While licensing, allowance is granted by the patent owner to another person or organization for using the patented invention on agreed terms and conditions and the patent owner continues to maintain his/her ownership. So, by combining the concept of the technology transfer with IP creation and licensing, this workshop will touch upon the relevant legal, practical and economical aspects. It will also cover the key issues to be taken into account by companies/startups through the different stages of product development cycle and during the IP commercialization process. This

workshop is designed in a manner to ensure that the participants will acquire the required understanding and will realize the importance of IP licensing and technology transfer.
