Parichay Patra is working as the Indian Co-PI of an MHRD funded SPARC project on the Indian National Emergency of 1975-77, censorship, film policy and aesthetic freedom. His co-edited volume on the Filipino auteur Lav Diaz is forthcoming from Intellect in 2020. Interested primarily in the global cinematic waves in the 1970s and the Indian New Wave's transnational associations, he is currently completing his first monograph based on his recent archival research in Argentina.

Her documentary film *Under Another Sky* will be released shortly.
